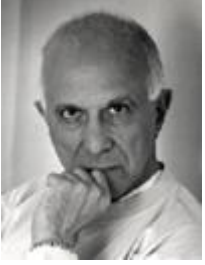
**The Exceptional Summer Program** starts tomorrow!
